Dear Ms. Viana,

I can confirm that no application was received from the Township of Berkeley Heights in 2010, 2011, or 2013 for the Kids Recreation Trust Fund.

It is the goal of the Trust Fund and the Freeholders to be able to provide funding to all 21 municipalities every year. At the request of the BHPAL, funds had been earmarked, but were never applied for by the Township in those years.

Ultimately, in 2014, through initiative taken by the BHPAL, its Treasurer and Secretary, this organization worked with the Trust Fund office to reclaim and draw down on those funds.

I hope this helps to clarify your request.
